Independent Auditor's Review Report on Unaudited Quarterly Financial Results of the Company pursuant to the Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended)

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results ('the Statement') of Alipurduar Transmission Limited ('the Company') for the quarter ended 30 June 2026, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended) ('Listing Regulations').
2. The Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34, Interim Financial Reporting ('Ind AS 34'), prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and is in compliance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of Regulation 52 of the Listing Regulations. - The above Financial Results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors of Alipurduar Transmission Limited ("the Company") at the meeting held on 15th July, 2026. The Statutory Auditors have carried out the limited review of these financial results of the Company for the quarter ended on 30th June, 2026.
- Pursuant to Regulation 54 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Company has maintained 100% security cover on its Listed Non-convertible Debentures (NCDs) of ₹ 782.50 Crores as on 30th June, 2026. Non-Convertible Debentures are secured by having first charge over movable/intangible assets created out of project on pari passu basis.
- The Company had issued redeemable non-convertible debentures. The Company has been creating Debenture Redemption Reserve (DRR) out of the profits which are available for payment of dividend for the purpose of redemption of debentures as per the relevant provisions of the Companies Act 2013.
- The Company is primarily engaged in the business of establishing commissioning, setting up, operating and maintaining electric power transmission systems/ networks, power systems, generating stations for transmission, distribution or supply of power through establishing or using stations, tie-lines, sub-stations and transmission or distributions lines and has single Long Term Transmission Customer. The entire business has been considered as a single segment in terms of Ind AS - 108 on Segment Reporting issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. There being no business outside India, the entire business has been considered as single geographic segment.

The Guidance Note requires that we comply with the ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics issued by the ICAI.
